- idea feasibility
- experience in the sector
- economic proposal
- 1. The training/workshop will be provided for a maximum of 20 participants.
- 2. Transportation and meals will be provided to all of them.
- 3. After the training and the submission of a Business Plans Canvas, the best winning entrepreneurs/teams will get the opportunity to receive financial support (endowment fund) up to 10.000 € for the implementation of their Circular Economy Business.
